FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

One of the goals of Christ the King School is to provide quality education to all students. A tuition assistance scholarship fund has been established for the sole purpose of assisting any student who meets the criteria of financial need as set up by the scholarship guidelines. Families who would like to apply for financial assistance from CEF must fill out the financial form provided by CEF, along with the appropriate documentation before being considered for any assistance. **No assistance will be awarded to families without the required paperwork on file with the principal.**

PARENT VOLUNTEER PROGRAM:

Volunteering is an excellent opportunity for you to get involved in the parish community, and you are strongly encouraged to invest your time in both school and church activities. Your involvement along with that of everyone else is what makes our community strong and prosperous. Each family is required to volunteer 10 hours annually. Parents who do not complete the required number of service hours will be billed \$15 for every missing hour required.

FUNDRAISING:

Each family is required to meet a Fundraising Requirement of \$320 through Chocolate Sales and Raffle. Other fundraising opportunities such as the Fun Run, Krispy Kreme and Spell-A-Thon are mandatory to participate in but amounts raised may vary.
